Soroptimists are women of all ages, cultures and ethnic groups. They represent a wide array of professions/skill sets and contribute time and financial support to community-based and international projects that benefit women and girls.

SOROPTIMIST INTERNATIONAL

Soroptimist International, a not for profit organization, is an association of Soroptimist Federations. The first club was founded in 1921 in California. Soroptimist International is headquartered in Cambridge, England.

Soroptimist International is a global women's organization whose members volunteer to improve the lives of women and girls. More than 75,000 Soroptimist in 122 countries and territories join together to help make the world a better place for humankind. The organization is concerned with providing women and girls access to education, the most effective path to self-determination.

SIGLV participates in the following Awards:

Live Your Dream Education & Training Awards for Women annually disburses about \$2 million in education grants to more than 1,500 women who have overcome enormous personal obstacles.

Ruby Award: For Women Helping Women acknowledges women who are working to improve the lives of women and girls through their personal and professional activities.

Service Projects

SIGLV works on many local and global projects that benefit women including:

Soroptimist's Dream It, Be It: Career Support for Girls helps girls grow up to be strong, successful, happy adults. The program provides girls with access to professional role models, career education and resources to live their dreams. We host, annually, with other local Soroptimist clubs, a day-long conference for secondary school-age girls, where they will learn about career opportunities, setting and achieving goals, and overcoming obstacles to success.

Break These Chains-Live Free is a partnership of Southern Nevada Soroptimist clubs. The 501(c) (3) organization focuses attention on and educates the public on the problems of human trafficking. BTC organizes an annual high school art contest, Human Trafficking-The Ugly Truth, which reflected, through art, the dehumanizing of one's body and soul. The contest finalists become part of a traveling exhibit that draws awareness to this troubling issue in our community and throughout the state.
