This year, Teens Helping Teens (THT) is one of SIGLV's service projects. THT was founded by two sisters several years ago as a school project to provide assistance by teenagers to homeless and displaced teenagers who are trying to attend school. The project grew quickly and is now a nonprofit 501c3 organization, providing assistance directly to teens, by teens, who have little or just the clothes on their backs.

THT works community wide, going directly to the streets, and supports other non profits, such as Safe Nest, YMCA, Big Brothers/Big Sister, Partners for Homeless Youth and many more. Their help is in the form of donations of teen appropriate clothing (teens want to look cool and fit in), school
